Vietnamese Ambassador to Japan Visits Yamaguchi University

On the 5th of February, the Vietnamese Ambassador to Japan, Nguyen Phu Binh, visited Yamaguchi University's Yoshida Campus. The Ambassador visited Yamaguchi University President, Dr. Marumoto, to discuss the possibility of future cooperative projects with the University. President Marumoto expressed his interest in collaborating with the Embassy in the field of agriculture as Vietnam is largely an agrarian nation. As Japan is advanced in the fields of industry and education, President Marumoto spoke of his wish to provide technical support in these fields.

Following his visit to the President's office, the Ambassador gave an address at a Meeting attended by the President, Vice-Presidents and Deans and Head of Schools from each Faculty regarding the training and cultivation of today's youth. He expressed how the development and advancement of Vietnam depends on the proper training of today's youth and how Yamaguchi University's cooperation is vital in increasing the number of doctoral recipients.
